Message from Mr Blyghton, Headteacher

If a member of your household has tested positive for Covid-19 please \underline{DO} <u>NOT</u> send your son or daughter into school. They <u>MUST</u> stay at home as isolate.

If a member of your household orders/takes a test, the whole household MUST self isolate, until a result has been received.

This will reduce the need for the School to send other students home as a result of an attendance by somebody who should have been self-isolating or was exhibiting symptoms.

However, if your son or daughter or someone within the household receives a positive test result over a weekend, please email my PA at headspa@beths.bexley.sch.uk as this enables us to react over the weekend and, if it is necessary to ask students to remain at home to self-isolate, a decision can be made then rather than having to send them home on the Monday.

We have recently received a request from our neighbours to ask that those sixth form students driving to school, do not park over parts of their driveways, please, as this restricts their entry and exit.

As we like to celebrate our former students, "Olivia meets Her Match" starring footballer Bradley Dack is currently airing on the ITV Hub. Bradley was at the school between 2005 and 2010 and has only recently come back from a serious injury so hopefully he will be playing again regularly for Blackburn Rovers.

- Flavour with your favourite herbs
- Cook the base of your pie (pre-rolled bought pastry) for 20 minutes in a hot oven
- Add the pastry sides to the pie
- Add the filing and the pastry top

When tested for Covid...

If your son or daughter is tested for Covid-19, please alert the school and do not allow them to return until they have received a negative test result. Again, should they be unfortunate enough to test positive, please inform the school immediately so that we can alert the LCRC for guidance.

Similarly, should anyone within your household take a test for Covid-19, we ask that your child remain at home until the test results are known. If the result is positive, they will need to continue

to remain at home isolating for 14 days from the start of the symptoms or, if there were none, for 14 days from the date the test was taken.

If you have any queries regarding isolation and what you should do, please contact the school and we will try to help you out.

We would also like to reassure you that we will also endeavour to include your son or daughter in lessons as they are taught. We have had some excellent lessons taking place within the classroom with absent students taking part at the same time via Zoom or Microsoft Teams.
