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MESSAGE FROM THE HEADTEACHER



Dear Parents, Carers,

With the summer heat coming upon us now, we have moved to our summer school uniform. Students were made aware of this during form time this week, but to recap, blazers do not need to be worn in school (except for those sitting public examinations). Should the weather take a turn, students can wear their school jumpers, but no hoodies.

We are halfway through the public examinations now, students have prepared themselves well, displaying professionalism whilst sitting the exams. I hope they reap the rewards in August, for all the hard work they have put into these examinations.

Our first Year 9 Cuffley's camp took place this week, with the students experiencing a number of activities and learning new skills. Our second group leaves on the 21st June and our 'Year 8 Camp' returns next month.

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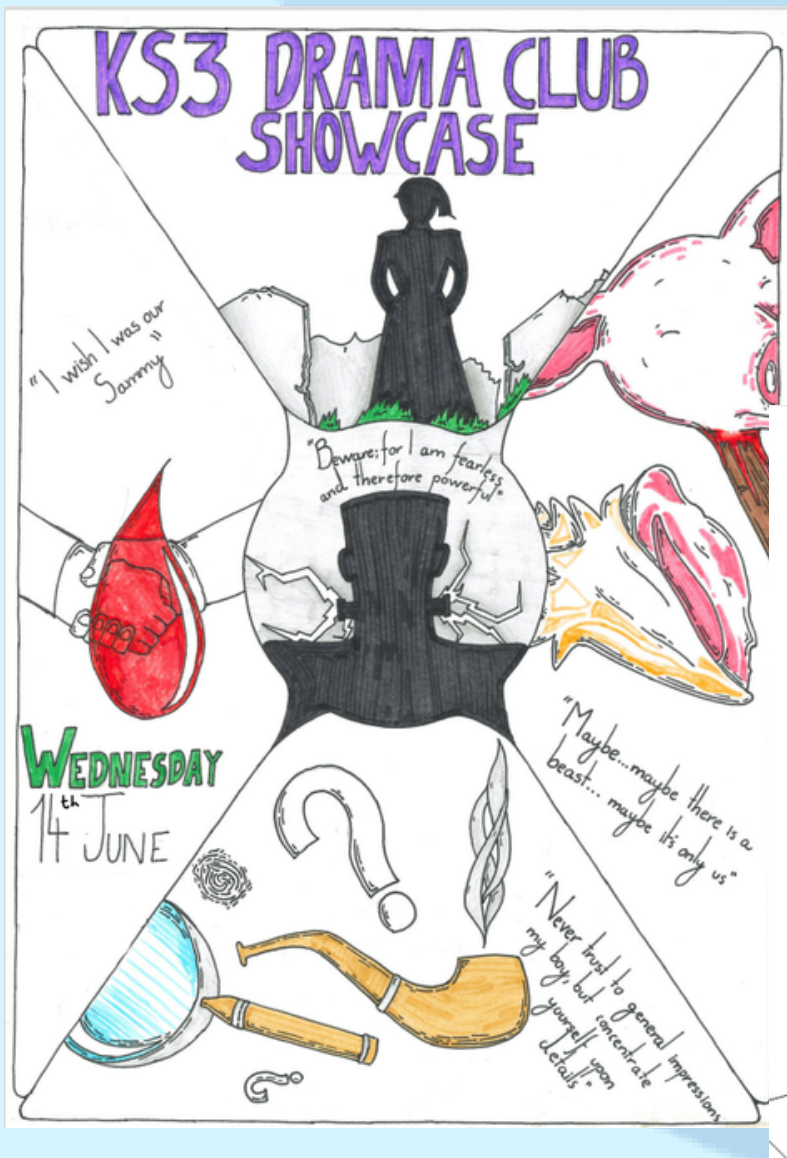
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KS3 DRAMA SHOWCASE

Summary of plays:

Students have adapted plays of their choice to suit a modern audience. Each play is an extract from their chosen text.

The Woman in Black by Susan Hill adapted by Stephen Mallatrate

The plot, set in early 20th-century England, follows a young recently widowed lawyer who travels to a remote village where he discovers that the vengeful ghost of a scorned woman is terrorising the locals.

Blood Brothers by Willy Russell

The story is a contemporary nature versus nurture plot, revolving around fraternal twins Mickey and Eddie, who were separated at birth, one subsequently being raised in a wealthy family, the other in a poor family.

Frankenstein by Mary Shelley adapted by Philip Pullman

Frankenstein tells the story of gifted scientist Victor Frankenstein who succeeds in giving life to a being of his own creation. However, this is not the perfect specimen he imagines that it will be, but rather a hideous creature who is rejected by Victor and mankind in general.

Lord of the Flies by William Golding adapted by Nigel Williams

The plot concerns a group who are stranded on an uninhabited island and their disastrous attempts to govern themselves. Themes include the tension between groupthink and individuality, between rational and emotional reactions, and between morality and immorality.

Sherlock Holmes by Sir Arthur Conan Doyle

When a string of brutal murders terrorises London, it doesn't take long for Sherlock Holmes and his crime-solving partner, Dr. Watson to find the killer.



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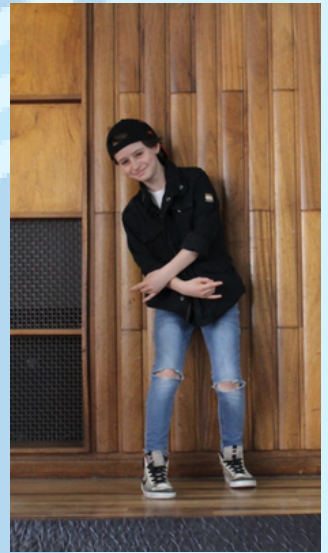
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BETHS MULTICULTURAL SOCIETY

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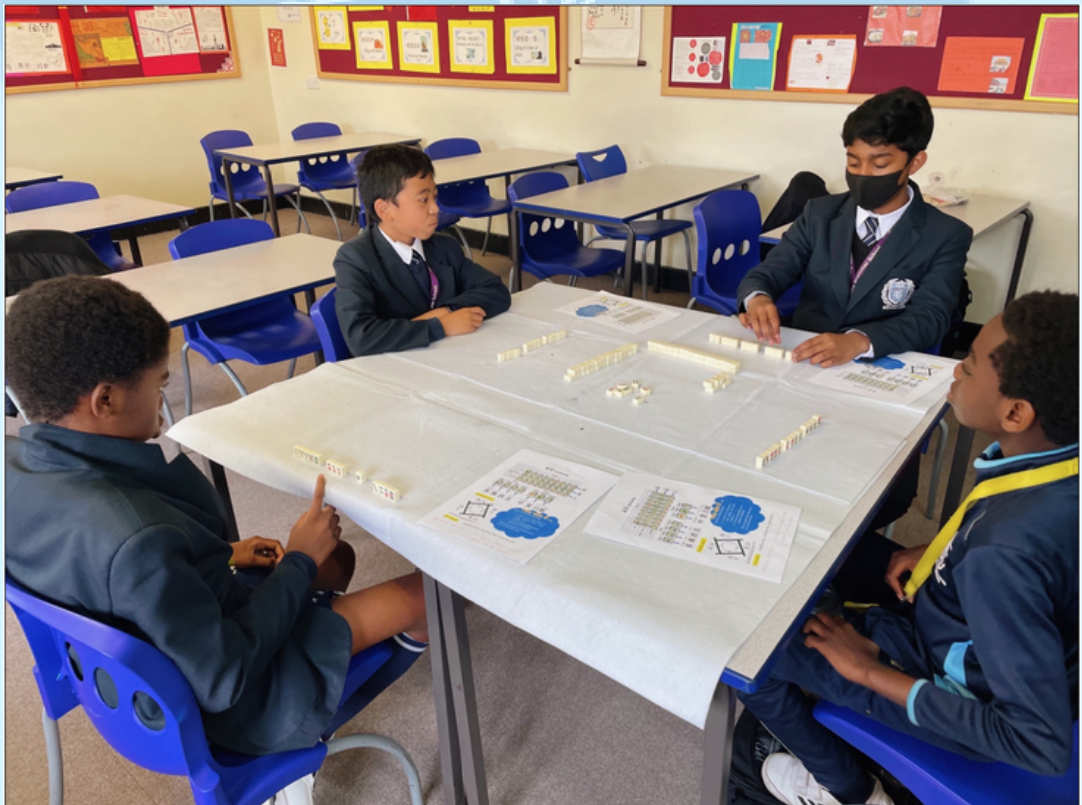
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CHINESE EXPERIENCE CLUB


