### MESSAGE FROM THE HEADTEACHER



Dear Parents, Carers,

The public examinations have reached the halfway point and we are proud of our students for the professional approach they have taken to these exams, even if they are feeling somewhat nervous, the studying and efforts they have put into their revision will pay off when their results come in.

You may have seen in the news of the train strikes to take place this month. There are two dates which may affect some students travelling via train - Tuesday 21st and Thursday 23rd June. Please ensure your son/daughter arrives in plenty of time for their exams as they must start at 9am and 1:30pm.


