Re: Covid-19 in Bexley schools

We would like to thank you for your positive response to the vaccination programme for children in Bexley who are 12-15 years of age. A second dose of the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine is now being recommended for all children aged 12-15 years old, at a minimum of 12 weeks from the first dose. Your child may have already received their first dose as part of the school's vaccination programme or at a local vaccination centre.

You might like to know that a 'Family Vaccination Day' has been arranged, where parents and their children (aged 12+) can be vaccinated together with their first, second or booster jabs. The details are as follows:

During KS3 Design and Technology club, the students are using various machinery to make bird houses. The Year 10 students have also just finished making desk organisers and phone holders.




