1	Watch a Spanish film (at a school event or on Netflix) and write a 40 word review of the film in Spanish – what is it about, did you like it and why and would you recommend it to a friend?	Research a tradition or festival from the Spanish-speaking world and create an informative poster for display.	Change the language of your phone / tablet / games console to Spanish or play your favourite video game with the language in Spanish. You must provide screenshot evidence over time.	Take part in an event as part of language and culture week. E.g. cultural dress day, food tasting
2	Learn a Spanish poem or song (to sing or play on an instrument) or a scene from a film or a play and record a video of yourself performing it. It could be a modern piece or a traditional one.	Research a region of the Spanish- speaking world and either create an information booklet advertising the region in Spanish for display or give a short presentation in class.	Find a website for language learning and play its games/activities in Spanish. You must provide screenshot evidence www.conjuguemos.com /activities/spanish/verb/1	Attend a Spanish extra-curricular club consistently for six weeks.
3	Cook or bake a traditional dish from the Spanish-speaking world and bring in the food or photos of it. Write the recipe and name of the dish in Spanish.	Research a historical figure from the Spanish-speaking world (e.g. an artist, musician, political leader or scientist) and create a fact file in Spanish on PPT for display or to present in class.	Deliver a 3 minute presentation in Spanish about your hobbies or something you like. This could be recorded as a video or presented in person.	Attend a Spanish trip or take part in an in-school Spanish event.
4	Either: Write or adapt a short fairy tale / story in Spanish Or: Read the English translation of a traditional piece of literature from the Spanish-speaking world and write a report on it in Spanish.	Read a Spanish news article on a current issue and write up a summary of the news story in Spanish.	Deliver a 5 minute instructional tutorial (alone or in a group) teaching a grammar point in Spanish. This could be recorded as a video or presented in person.	Go to a local event, gallery or museum exhibition related to the Spanish-speaking world and take photos as evidence.
