School Gateway App for Parents/Carers

We aim to make delivery of correspondence from school to home as efficient as possible by emailing bulk correspondence to parents using a service called School Comms. We also use both emails and text messages to contact you if your child is absent without explanation. Occasionally we also send urgent information via text message. School Comms offer a free smartphone app (Android and IPhone), which allows us to send notifications free of charge that you can also reply to for free.

As part of our behaviour and rewards policy we are also keen to share more information with parents as to how your child is applying themselves in school. The app will allow you to see daily any commendations that they receive. We believe that regular reporting of rewards to parents significantly improves the motivation of students at school. In addition, through the app you can see if there have been any problems at school and can monitor your child's behaviour. You will also be able to see your child's timetable, attendance information, and progress reports when they are issued.

Please support us by downloading the app to your phone - this will help us improve communication with you and also save the school money. The set-up process is simple and will take no more than a couple of minutes:
