BIOLOGY LESSONS



Over the past few weeks, year 12 scholars have been developing their practical skills in A-level Biology. They have worked ethically with small living organisms called Daphnia, which are amazing to look at under the microscope as they are transparent. Their transparency makes it easy to monitor their heart rate, as contractions can be easily observed and counted. Scholars have also worked to calculate Vitamin C concentrations in various fruit juices. Vitamin C is an important part of a balanced diet and research has shown that it is linked to cardiovascular health.

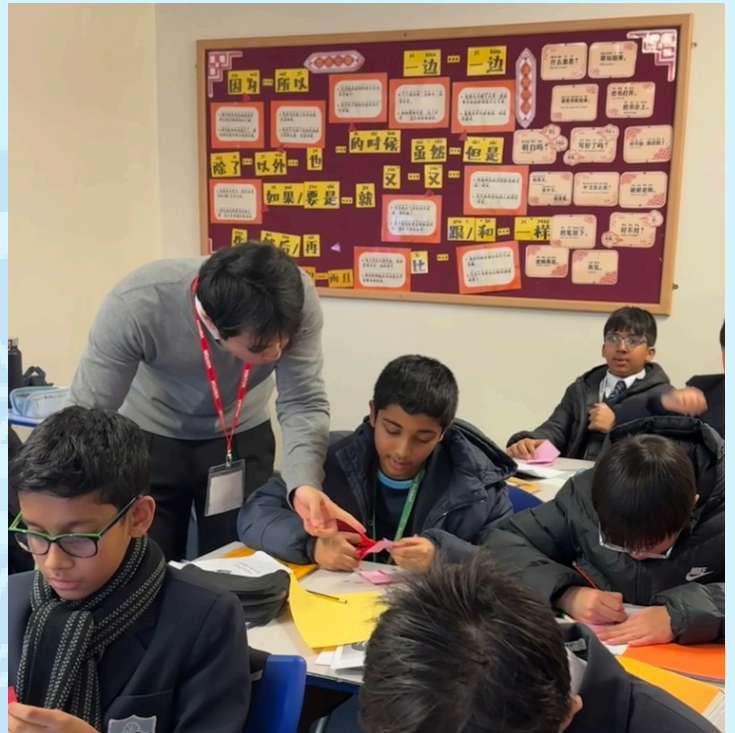


