At Beths Grammar School we believe a period of work-related learning gives students the opportunity to experience a real working environment and to develop key skills that they will need in their working lives. It is a great opportunity to provide evidence for personal statements and CVs.

The school uses the Unifrog Placement Tool to process the health and safety checks. We also provide a Health and Safety and Safeguarding briefing for all students.

The whole year group will be doing work experience **Monday 29 June to Friday 3 July 2026**. Therefore, there will be no lessons this week.

Parents/carers have an important role to play in helping their child find a placement and completing the administration of the programme. The guides and tools on finding work experience and how to upload details to Unifrog can be found on the school website:

Please do not limit the search to direct links to future careers, as this can make it challenging to secure a placement. Transferrable skills can be obtained in any workplace. Please encourage your child to use their existing networks (friends and family) and to reach out to their old primary school and local businesses such as pharmacies, who are often willing to accommodate students on work experience. **Please note that overseas placements will not be approved and placements should not take place with sole traders for safeguarding reasons.**

The deadline to upload the details to Unifrog is **Monday 2 March 2026** to ensure that all Health and Safety checks can be carried out. Please note that some placements will require a DBS check, which takes time to process (the application and fee will be the responsibility of student). Students who do not find a placement will be expected to do a virtual placement. This should not be the first choice.

We really hope your child embraces this opportunity to undertake in person work experience.
