Highlights of the Term

Foodbank donations

Attendance and punctuality

The attendance and punctuality of Year 7 scholars is outstanding. To date, the attendance of Year 7 is 97.5%, exceeding the average of the local authority. I am particularly pleased with members of Hurst, whose attendance is the highest within the year group at 98.9% and well done to the 77 students in the year group who have 100% attendance.

It's always a pleasure to monitor scholar points and see scholars taking up opportunities to excel inside and outside of the classroom. As well as monitoring scholar points, my job as Head of Year is to monitor the number of behaviour points in the year group and I'm delighted to say 95 scholars in the year group have no behaviour points. That is outstanding behaviour for learning and I think it is important to celebrate not only those students who are getting scholar points but also those who are consistently doing what they are meant to do and ensuring they have all their equipment for lessons. Particular praise should go to Hurst where 68% of students have received no behaviour points.

KS3 Carol Service

One of our highlights of the Autumn term is always the KS3 Carol Service at Christchurch. This year the church was a little emptier as only Y7 and Y8 were in attendance. Despite that, scholars were in fine voice, belting out carols and behaviour was exemplary. Special congratulations go to students who played music during the service and to those that read.
