

Labour Market Information

Labour Market Information (LMI) means statistics about employment.

The importance of LMI

LMI can be useful for young people to consider when they are deciding what careers, education and training routes they want to pursue. For example, if someone is deciding between two career routes, they might use LMI to decide which one is more attractive to them.

Governments and specialist organisations analyse employment figures in order to make decisions about policy. For example, a government might decide to invest in more training places for nurses if LMI shows that there will be a shortage of nurses in the future.

The LMI would include information such as:
