YR 8 CROSS-CURRICULAR ITALIAN PROJECT - VENEZIAN CARNIVALE

"Year 8 Italian Students Celebrate Venetian Carnival Through Creativity and Culture"

This term, our Year 8 Italian learners embarked on an exciting cross-curricular project exploring one of Italy's most famous cultural celebrations: the Venetian Carnival (Carnevale di Venezia).

The project began with students carrying out detailed research in the ICT suites, where they discovered the fascinating history of Venice's world-renowned carnival. They learned about the traditions of the festival, its importance in Italian culture, and the distinctive masks that have become symbols of the event. Students investigated famous mask types such as the Bauta, Colombina, and Medico della Peste (Plague Doctor), exploring their origins and significance.

Using their research, students then moved on to the design stage, creating original mask concepts using Canva. This allowed them to experiment with colours, patterns, and decorative features while drawing inspiration from traditional Venetian designs. Their creativity flourished as they produced unique digital designs that combined historical influences with their own artistic ideas.

The most enjoyable part of the project was bringing these designs to life. Students carefully handcrafted and decorated their own Venetian masks, using a range of materials to create impressive, finished products. The classroom was transformed into a vibrant workshop as learners demonstrated great patience, attention to detail, and artistic talent.

To conclude the project, students prepared and delivered presentations in Italian to their classmates. They shared facts about Venice, explained the history of the Venetian Carnival, and described the inspiration behind their mask designs using the Italian language they have been studying throughout the year. This final task allowed students to develop their speaking and presentation skills while showcasing their cultural knowledge.

The project was a wonderful example of how language learning can be brought to life through creativity, research, and hands-on activities. Our Year 8 students should be extremely proud of their achievements. They demonstrated excellent enthusiasm, independence, and imagination while developing their understanding of Italian culture and improving their language skills.
